

Maintenance Platform Operating Instructions

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING MANUFACTURERS GUIDELINES AND RECOMMENDATIONS:-

The machine should be fitted with a crowd/rotational lock out device before the attachment is fitted and used. Should this not be fitted, please contact your dealer for advice.

To attach your platform - Tine Fixing

- Set pallet tines to correct spacing and lock to avoid sideward movement
- 2. Drive fully into sockets provided on platform
- Insert locking pin behind pallet tines (to prevent forward attachment) and secure with lynch pin

DO NOT STAND UNDER RAISED ATTACHMENT

To attach to your platform - Bracket Fixing

- 1. Hook up materials handler to attachment fully crowded back
- 2. Extend locking pins either manually or hydraulically to ensure attachment to materials handler. Visually check they are in the correct position.

Maintenance Platform Operating Instructions

Recommendations for Safe Operation

- 1. Always have forklift manned at all times
- Load platform with minimum of tools and equipment required and keep tidy
- 3. Larger equipment should be attached to platform rails by safety chains
- 4. Do not drive with platform raised or use on soft or uneven/sloping ground
- 5. Position as close as possible to work projects
- Always stand on platform base do not attempt to gain extra height by climbing on safety rails
- 7. Keep area below platform clear of people. (The platform is fitted with kicker boards and weldmesh to avoid accidental discharge of tools and equipment but there is still a danger of falling objects)
- 8. Keep platform level
- 9. Do not use your maintenance platform for any other purpose than it was intended to be used for
- 10. Do not attach weights
- 11. Maximum operating height; 6m
